## Signalment:

Species: Equine

## Presenting Complaint:

• Respiratory disease: clear nasal discharge

Off feed

• Colic

#### History:

• Viral respiratory infection as a yearling

- Right lung consolidation noted during colic work-up 10 months ago
- Has been at trainer's barn, who noticed possible respiratory disease, including clear nasal discharge
- Has lost 200 pounds over the last month

### Physical Examination:

• Temperature: 99.7 °F

• Heart rate: 68 beats per minute

• Respirations: 20 breaths per minute

• Temperament: depressed

• Auscultation of thorax: decreased lung sounds on left, increased heart sounds on right

• Rectal palpation: pelvic flexure impaction

#### Plan:

- Thoracic ultrasound
- Thoracic radiography
- Complete blood count
  - o Leukopenia
  - o Neutropenia with left shift
  - o Slight anemia
  - o Hyperproteinemia
  - o Hyperfibrinogenemia
- Chemistry
  - o Hyperglycemia
  - Azotemia

- o Hypoalbuminemiao Hyperglobulinemia
